GUIDELINES FOR YES PE

1. Eligibility & Registration Protocol :-

- **Eligibility:**

Participation is strictly restricted to bonafide students currently enrolled in Classes 9 to 12.

- **Registration Window:**

The fully digital on boarding process will open on the official website of LNIPE, Gwalior (www.lnipe.edu.in) through YES-PE portal from **10th May 2026 at 10:00 AM** and will officially close on **25th May 2026 at 05:00 PM**.

- **Verification & Identity:**

Each candidate will receive a Unique Application ID upon successful registration. Providing any false information regarding age or school enrollment will lead to immediate disqualification.

2. Competition Schedule :-

- The YES PE national competition is open for 9th to 12th-grade students across India. The competition will open on **10th May 2026 at 10:00 AM** and officially closing on **25th May, 2026 at 5:00 PM**.
- The competition result will be declared through the website on **30th May, 2026** the top-performing youth from across the country will be selected to attend a special 5-day Experiential Learning Programme at LNIPE, Gwalior, to help integrate them into the world of sports and physical education.

3. Selection Methodology & Tie-Break Protocol :-

- **Merit-Based Selection:** A state-wise merit ranking will be generated by the AI assessment tool, evaluating participants on creativity, leadership values, and analytical thinking. Exactly 144 YES PE Ambassadors will be selected nationally (4 students from each State/UT: 2 Boys, 2 Girls).
- **Tie-Break Protocol (Merit):** In the event that two or more students within the same State/UT secure identical assessment scores for the final available slot, the selection tie-break will be strictly determined by the below written Tie-Breaks in order :
 - **Tie-Break 1** : (a) Student studying in higher class will be preferred.
(b) If class is same then date of birth (DOB). The elder student will be given preference for the final selection.
 - **Tie-Break 2** : Computerized Random Draw of Lots.

4. Travel Logistics upon Arrival :-

- **Travel Reimbursement:**

- ✓ Travel expenses for the selected participant and accompanied escort (parent/teacher) will be reimbursed strictly for **3rd AC rail travel one round-trip only**. Original tickets and PNR details must be submitted to the YES-PE travel desk upon arrival for processing.

- ✓ Travelling in class below 3rd AC will be reimbursed the actual price of the ticket.

- **Accommodation:**

Boarding, lodging and food for the 144 selected candidates along with accompanied escort (parent/teacher) will be provided by the LNIPE for the entire duration of the Experiential Learning Programme.

Other information related to Experiential Learning Programme will be released with the result on 30th May, 2026.

5. General Rules & Regulations :-

- **Code of Conduct:** All participants are expected to maintain the highest standards of integrity. Any use of unfair means, plagiarism, or unauthorized assistance during the digital competition will result in a permanent ban from the program.

- **Medical Fitness:** To actively participate in the on-campus intergroup sports and physical activities (like Athletics, Adventure Sports and Tug of War etc.), candidates must present a basic medical fitness certificate from a registered medical practitioner upon arrival.
